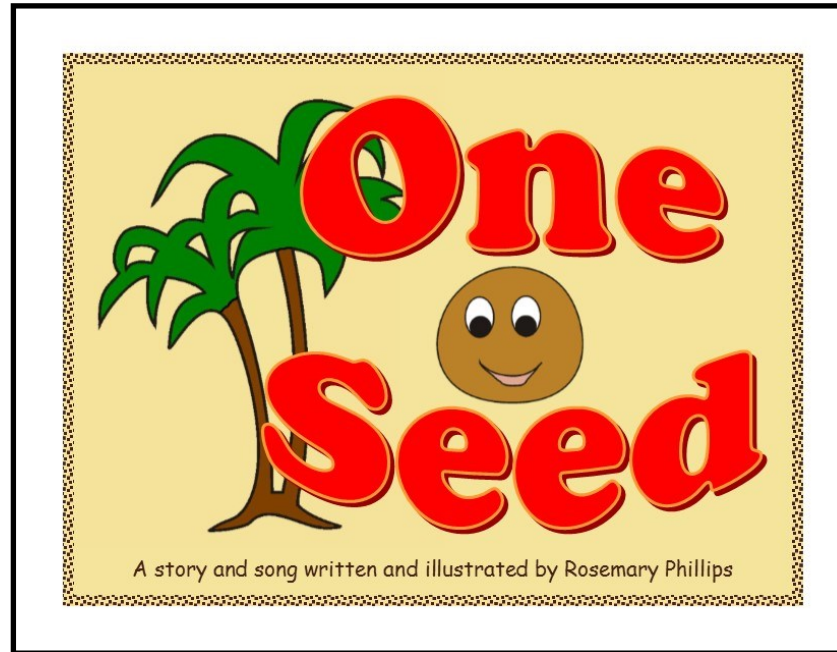

## What comes from a seed?

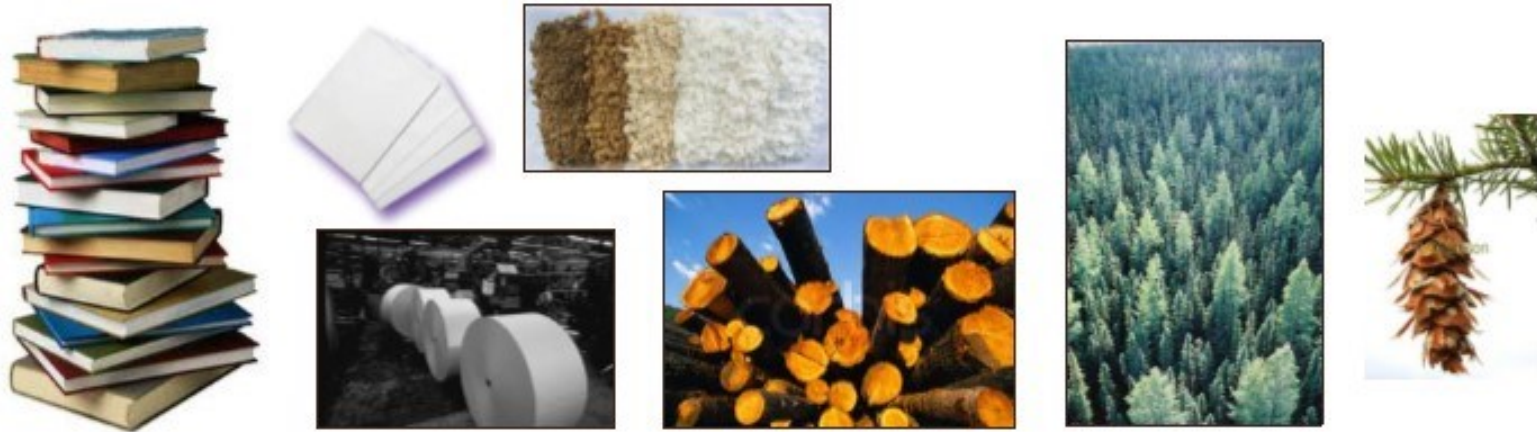
To give you an idea, an apple comes from a tree which comes from a seed.
